1. Has the applicant performed in their Troop and patrol **actively** and dependably for **at least** 6 months since becoming a Life Scout?

2. Does the applicant demonstrate Scout spirit by living the Scout Oath and Scout Law in their everyday life?

3. Has the applicant earned the following merit badges: a) Camping; b) Citizenship in the Community; c) Citizenship in the Nation; d) Citizenship in the World; e) Communication; f) Cooking; g) Emergency Preparedness OR Lifesaving; h) Environmental Science OR Sustainability; i) First Aid; j) Swimming OR Hiking OR Cycling; k) Personal Management; l) Personal Fitness; and m) Family Life, plus 8 others, for a total of 21?

4. While a Life Scout, has the applicant served actively for a period of 6 months in one or more of the following positions of responsibility: Senior Patrol Leader, Assistant Senior Patrol Leader, Chaplain Aide, Den Chief, Instructor, Junior Assistant Scoutmaster, Librarian, Patrol Leader, Historian, Quartermaster, Scribe, Troop Guide, Order of the Arrow Troop Representative, Webmaster, or Outdoor Ethics Guide?

5. While a Life Scout, did the applicant plan, develop and give leadership to others in a service project helpful to any religious institution, any school, or your community? The project must be initiated by the scout and a detailed project written proposal must be approved by: the organization it will benefit, you, your unit committee, and the District prior to the work commencing. This Project should be a major test as to whether the Scouting program has succeeded in developing the traits reflected in the Scout Oath and Law in this candidate. The scout must use the Eagle Scout Service Project Workbook, No. 18-927 in fulfilling this requirement.

6. At the Scoutmaster's Conference, did the applicant show:
 - a) An understanding and appreciation of the ideals of Scouting?
 - b) An understanding of the meaning and obligations of the Eagle Rank?

7. From your own observation, has the applicant demonstrated an effort:
 - a) To live by the Scout Oath and Law?
 - b) To apply the principles of effective leadership?
 - c) To demonstrate a consistent regard for the care of their own and other people's property?
 - d) Show respect for the rights and opinions of others?
 - e) Demonstrated good citizenship when not in a position of responsibility?
